

National Water Hygiene Course

Course Name

The National Water Hygiene Card is also known as the Energy and Utility Skills 'Blue Card'. It has been developed with the water industry to provide a uniform approach to hygiene training in line with Drinking Water Inspectorate advice.

Who needs this qualification?

Many water companies require workers who visit drinking water sites to have this registration.

Course Content

The half-day course covers four modules with water hygiene, public health and environmental content.

1. The importance of water
2. Water as a carrier of disease
3. Potential contamination and its consequences
4. Preventing contamination

Where is the training held?

Open Public Courses are held regularly in Warrington. Alternatively, courses may be delivered at your premises if you have up to 12 people that require training. E-learning is available 24/7. How much does it cost?

The cost is dependant on location and numbers of people that require the training. Please call or email for further information.

Key Facts

The National Water Hygiene card is valid for three years from the date of the course. A good command of the English language is required to pass the end of course test.

Duration

A half working day should be allowed for the course. Up to 12 people may attend each course.
